Road Markers

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7 miles to Sing Sing and 40 to N. York

- Miles: 7 miles to Sing Sing and 40 to N. York
- Location Description: Yorktown Museum, Yorktown Community & Cultural Center, Top Floor, 1974 Commerce Street, Yorktown Heights, NY 10598; Phone: (914) 962-2970; <http://www.yorktownmuseum.org/>
- History: The marker was originally located near Pines Bridge where Route 100 intersects Route 118 in Yorktown. In 1942, a local farmer moved the marker to be used as a doorstep outside his barn. A member of the Westchester County Historical Society found it and placed it back near Pines Bridge, encasing it in a protective stone structure. Circa 1987, the stone was taken by a disgruntled construction worker involved in maintenance on the open deck Pines Bridge. A few years later it was returned and given to the Yorktown Museum for safe keeping..

- Miles: 103 miles from New York
- Location Description: Near the Ellenville Public Library on Childs Street between Center Street (50 yd) and Canal Street (40 yd) in Ellenville, NY.
- History: The marker was originally a snubbing post for boats at the Delaware & Hudson Canal. The post became an Ontario & Western Railroad milestone. The marker was originally located near Napanoch in 1980. (Source #2)
